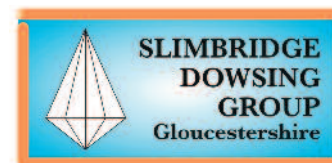
Liz says, 'This field trip will be about sensory archaeology and how we can use our senses to understand new information about habitation and use. We will be dowsing for hidden archaeological features, water lines and earth energies. Why did the Neolithic people choose this spot to build a tomb for their dead and honour their ancestors here? Ghost stories, folklore and the mystery of the portal skull will all be revealed on this extraordinary exploration.'

Please note that the walk to the barrow is up hill and will take approximately 25 minutes at a slowish pace. Please bring wet weather gear and stout foot wear.

Liz Poraj-Wilczynska is an artist and archaeographer, an excellent guide, and has spent many years investigating Belas Knap long barrow and the landscape around it. You may have seen her talking about it on TV.

Protecting and Cleansing

We are all taught from Day One to protect ourselves before dowsing anything, particularly on field trips to burial sites, plague pits and similar.

Rob Gerrish has suggested that there is a further dimension to this, and writes as follows: 'I am constantly learning in my dowsing experiences and thought this worth sharing.

'Through my reading, I have picked up an additional step to add to our list of things we do before and after dowsing. The cleansing step is taken to remove any psychic energies or entities that may have affected or attached to us during our dowsing.

To do this you simply state 'Please cleanse me' whilst holding rod or pendulum; the pendulum stops spinning when completed and the rods move position when done.

I tried this out myself after doing a bit of simple dowsing by asking the question at the end of it, 'Do I need cleansing?' and it responded Yes!

After doing this simple cleansing procedure, the response changed to No.

I read that when doing dowsing in a room or hall, you should always cleanse the room afterwards so as not to inconvenience the people using it next.

Simply saying 'Please cleanse the room' works.'

Thursday 10th August **Dowsing for Post Houses at Keith's farm** with Barry Goldring



Barry writes, 'Last year John Wilson-Smith and I investigated some crop marks in one of Keith's fields. By dowsing, we found indications of two Roman posting houses, one around AD 200 and one later. We got some detail on the later one, and I subsequently wrote it up for the April issue of Dowsing Today.'

This time I want to get more detail on the AD 200 building, and attempt to find its predecessor that we believe may be nearby.

Directions: Take the turning to Frampton on Severn from the A38. Follow the Perry Way to Frampton, village green and Bell Inn on left. Cross canal via swing bridge, take left turn as you leave bridge. Continue to Arlingham, see Red Lion pub, turn left into Church Road. Pass church on right, take first turning left (Pound Lane). Go slow – a bit potholey. After half a mile the road forks, see field gate between the two roads, which leads up a tree-lined track. Hopefully Keith will leave gate unlocked so park under trees. It's a short walk to the posting house site.

*Meet for briefing at 10.30 a.m. under trees. We should enjoy a good dowsing session before returning to the **Red Lion for lunch** (and loos – **NO LOOS** on site!). Bring sandwiches if you prefer. Optional return to site for 2 p.m. afternoon session for those who have the stamina.*
